ROOM ADDITION PERMIT GUIDE

Application Requirements

- 1. Legal description of the property or parcel
- 2. Site Plan drawn and clearly labeled showing all existing structures and lot lines. Also, show area to be demolished, if any.
- 3. Scale drawings, blueprints, or brochures with plan view, side elevations, and dimensions
- 4. Registered Town of Hebron contractor and subcontractors for current year
- 5. Completed permit application form from this office

Town of Hebron, County and State Building Code and Zoning requirements

- 1. Plumbers must have Indiana State Plumbing License on file with the Town of Hebron
- 2. Side and rear yard setbacks must be respected
- 3. Site must be finished grade min. 6" within the first 10' with proper swales for drainage at property line
- 4. Gutters and downspouts installed
- 5. Smoke detectors installed and interconnected
- 6. Hand/guard rails on all decks, balconies, stairways, and landings. Turned into walls on all stairways.
- 7. Electrical panel labeled and all fixtures installed. All grounding in place.
- 8. Tempered glass used in showers/tubs
- 9. Separate gas valves for fireplaces must be accessible and labeled.
- 10. Underside of basement stairs should be drywall
- 11. Permit runs for 1 year. Fee to renew is same as original fee paid.

Minimum Required Zoning Setbacks

Zone R1 - Front 30' Side 15' Rear 20' Zone R2 - Front 25' Side 10' Rear 15'

Building Department Inspections Required – Call (219)-996-4641

- 1. Footing or post hole. Footing forms, rebar, and Ufer ground is in place. 36" frost depth, building footprint and site plan verification.
- 2. Pre-backfill after waterproofing, drain tile, and insulation are installed prior to backfill.
- 3. Underground plumbing/electrical prior to pouring floor. Please leave pipe joints uncovered.
- 4. Rough-in (4 way). When all framing, plumbing, electrical, HVAC, and fire/draft stopping are in place prior to wall covering. (Insulation may be in place in exterior walls)
- 5. Final Certificate of Occupancy Inspection when project is totally complete. Structure cannot be occupied without written permission from the Building Dept.
