Meeting Called to Order: 7:11 PM

Old Business: Discussed the 3 trees from Hubinger's that were planted on the East end of the trail.

Installation of border at new toddler area at McMillen Park was completed and the 2 benches at the trail have been secured.

Welcome Santa event is proceeding, we have booked Paint Time Fun for face painting at a cost of \$440.00 because we were unable to get Extreme Face Painting and Giggle & Smile Balloons and we have opted to not get a balloon person because cost was too high. Request for the donations for the Silent Auction have been distributed to the businesses in Town and we discussed some of the donations that have been made so far. We have a Santa for the event, it will be Don Fry again this year. Motion was made by Don, Cathy 2nd, to purchase 2 gift cards in the amount of 30.00 each, to thank our Santa. We will contact the Fire Dept. to make sure they can deliver Santa on the day of the event.

Motion was made by Don, Cathy 2nd to purchase the rest of the items needed for the day from Walmart, Dollar General and Oriental Trading not to exceed \$400.00, and to purchase an additional 3 dozen donuts from Casey's to add to the 5 dozen they are donating. Discussed that Family Express is donating 8 dozen Christmas cookies.

The Light up Hebron contest flyer has been posted and so far we only have 3 entrants.


The lights for the tree at the Community Center were put up but there are a few bare spots on the tree that we intend to go back and fill in.
