

**The Hebron Park Board** held its regularly scheduled meeting on November 9, 2023 at the Stagecoach Inn.

**The meeting was called to order** by President Linda at 7:08 pm.

**Treasurer's Report:** Account balances: \$2039.40 in maintenance and supplies, \$3001.06 in programs, zero in equipment, and \$12,910.25 in the gift fund. Don made a motion to approve the invoices; Dorothy seconded, and it passed. Don made a motion to approve the treasurer's report; Dorothy seconded, and the motion passed.

**Five-Year Park Plan:** No word yet from Mary Jane of M.J. and Associates.

**Old Business:** The Blue Spruce has been planted.

The town council has tabled the request from the person who wanted to do metal detecting in the parks.

The Christmas Park program will be Saturday, December 2. Santa, the balloon lady, and the 3 women who do the face painting are booked. Family Express will donate 10 dozen donuts. No response from Casey's yet.

**New Business:** Nothing is left over from the Easter Egg hunt. Dorothy made a motion for Linda to spend approximately \$500 for about 50 prizes at WalMart. Jenny seconded, and the motion passed. Don made a motion for Linda to use gift cards to purchase items to fill the Easter eggs. Jenny seconded, and the motion passed.

Don made a motion for Linda to spend \$75 to purchase incidentals such as paper towels, creamer, wrapping paper for the tables, etc. for the Christmas event. Dorothy seconded, and it passed.

First Church will be unable to help with the event due to a scheduling conflict.

Discussion was on what to encumber for 2024. Possibilities are plantings around the parks' signs, gift cards from Amazon for the Easter egg hunt, and more seeds for the trail.

Windows at the Depot will probably not be replaced but just refinished.

As there was no further business to come before the board, Don made a motion to adjourn; Jenny seconded, and the motion passed. The meeting closed at 8:42 pm.
