PUBLIC HEARING TOWN OF HEBRON, PORTER COUNTY, INDIANA COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The Town of Hebron, Porter County, Indiana, public hearing addressing a planning grant though OCRA for the Comprehensive Plan was held at 10:00 a.m. on the 28th day of April. In attendance for the Public Hearing was Donald Ensign, Vice President of the Hebron Redevelopment Commission (hereinafter referred to as "HRC"), Susan Alyea, Thomas & Associates, Jeff Brooks, Superintendent of MSD Boone Township School Corporation, and Joanne E. Hansen.

Mr. Ensign opened the public hearing. Susan Alyea gave a brief synopsis of the need for the Comprehensive Plan. She stated that the Comprehensive Plan is developed by utilizing a third-party consultant group with experience in such plan. She further stated that enable to assist with costs, the Town plans to apply for a planning grant which is available through OCRA. The Town will apply for a grant of \$45,000 with a match of \$10,000 being paid by HRC from the Tax Increment Financing Fund (TIF).

Mr. Ensign asked for comments. Superintendent Brooks stated that he supports the development of the Comprehensive Master Plan. There being no further comments, Mr. Ensign closed the public hearing.
