Josh Carter reported on the fire department. Stated that the drainage on the south side of the station needs to be looked at. What was done in 2021 did not correct the issue.

John Spinks inquired about turning the water off at 404 N. Main. Was informed that we can't do that.

Linda Brebner stated that the Easter Egg hunt will be April 16 at 10 a.m. at the Community Center. Josh Carter was asked if the fire department would please deliver the Easter Bunny to the Community Center.
