SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES OF MARCH 14, 2023**


Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the following business was conducted:

Public Hearing - Vacating of a portion of Quincy Street - President Spinks opened the Public Hearing and read the title of the proposed Ordinance as follows An Ordinance to Vacate an Unimproved Public Way Near the Address of Quincy Street, Hebron, Indiana which Public Way is an Undeveloped Roadway between 309 E. Casey Street on the East and 401 E.. Casey Street on the West. Clerk-Treasurer Jamie Uzelac reported that all costs associated with the public hearing have been paid and all people have been noticed. President Spinks asked for public comments and Council comments. There being no public comments nor council comments, on motion of Councilman Albright, seconded by Councilman Joseph, and duly carried 4-0, the public hearing was closed.

On motion of Councilman Peeler, seconded by Councilman Albright, and duly carried 4-0, **Ordinance 2023-03-14 - An Ordinance to Vacate an Unimproved Public Way Near the Address of Quincy Street, Hebron, Indiana which Public Way is an Undeveloped Roadway between 309 E. Casey Street on the East and 401 E.. Casey Street on the West** was passed and adopted.

There being no further business before the Council, on motion of Councilman Joseph, seconded by Councilman Albright, and duly carried 4-0, the meeting was adjourned.
