

WORKSHOP MINUTES

January 9, 2024

Jim Anton was in attendance to explain the Town's insurance costs. Questions were asked and answered.

Justin requested an executive session to talk about the building dept salary and a vehicle for Brad.

BZA- There will be a hearing on February 13, 2024, to discuss a variance for the residents at Wilson and Park Place.

Hire of a consultant – There was much discussion on the matter of hiring Susan Alyea as a consultant for the clerk's office, building dept, and Public works. It was determined that she would be hired for 1 year.

There was discussion on how much would be paid per day for meals for out of town functions, a raise in the mileage reimbursement and how hotels room would be taken care of.

John asked about an update concerning the 4th of July. That committee is not town related and is going to meet this week.

Police- Josh is asking that the pay rate for Probationary officers be moved to \$50,000.00 /year.

HRC – there will be an open house on January 31, 2024, at Mix Design from 5-7 pm. The Public is invited to attend.

Justin talked about parking problems on cul de sacs. It was stated that the traffic committee had proposed that parking be allowed only on 1 side.

Public Works – Randy stated that he had 6 people coming in for interviews for the Street Superintendent job on Wednesday the 10th. He and Mike Wallace would be conducting the interviews. He read his report and discussed the water tower project that is being finalized.

There was discussion on whether we increase the size for Windy Hill and make a change later if need be or just go with the smaller tower. Randy is to check with consultant for the cost difference.

John talked about a Readi Grant that the HRC is trying to get.

The Monroe Lift Station "fix" to carry us over till 2025 is going to be paid for by John Lotton according to John.
